AGES 5-9 Learning About Other Cultures Through Art (January 28 – April 28, 2012) JH-1 Learn About African, Asian, Navajo and Australian Art with Jennifer Henry. The objective of these four classes is to introduce children to other cultures and to learn that universal themes may exist in many cultures resulting in their unique art forms. All lessons target ages 5 to 9 years of age. Week 1: African Masks – Mixed Media; Week 2: The Willow Pattern – Painting; Week 3: The Weavings of the Navajo – Weaving; and Week 4: Aboriginal Art of Australia – Tooling Foil, markers, paint and oil pastels.

Transforming Junk Into Treasure (February 25, 2012) SK-1 Transforming Junk with Shari Keith (Ages 10-13) Join teaching artist Shari Keith, the Junk Lady, on a recycling journey to discover that you can truly transform junk into treasure. In this workshop students will be presented with a treasure trove of small, discarded objects. By analyzing the attributes of these objects with respect to the elements of design, participants will create personal artifacts that they can turn into purses, jewelry, key rings, or ornaments.
